

SWIMMING LESSONS 2022

Dear Parents,

My name is Paula Birch and I am the Centre Supervisor for In-term Swimming Lessons 2022 run by the Education Department, held at the Waroona Recreation and Aquatic Centre.

Lessons will commence daily on **Monday, 14 February (Wk 3)** and conclude on **Friday, 25th February (Wk 4)** for Pre Primary – Year 6. Lesson times will be as follows:

9.00am - 9.40am	Years 6 & 5
9.45am - 10.25am	Year 4
10.30am - 11.10am	Year 3
11.40am - 12.20pm	Year 2
12.25pm – 1.05pm	Year 1
1.10pm – 1.50pm	Pre Primary

I require the enrolment form to be **completed** and **returned** to the school by next **Friday, 11th March (Wk 2)** please.

1. If you are unsure about your child's stage in swimming please tick the box ***'Unsure please grade'***.
2. The 'stage number my child is going for' does not mean your child's age or year/class that your child is in at school.
3. It is really important that you write your child's **medical history** to ensure their safety at all times.
4. It is important you tick the 'My child has attempted this stage three times' box, if applicable.

The swimming teachers have requested that parents who would like to attend swimming lessons do so on Friday Week 3 and Friday Week 4 because children are often easily distracted when their parents watch them and this may affect their progress.

Dear Parents,

The children in Pre Primary to Year 6 will be participating in swimming lessons from Monday, 14th February (Wk 3), until Friday, 25th February (Wk 4). This is a total of ten lessons and is part of the normal Physical Education curriculum for all children.

To make changing easier, students may wear their swimming bathers underneath their school uniform during these ten days. Students will be permitted to wear thongs to school on these days also. They will **need a plastic bag to hold their towel** and dry (then wet) clothes. Please also remember to pack a spare set of underwear to change into after the lesson. Please make sure all clothing is labelled.

The students will be travelling by bus to and from the school. The students will be leaving approximately 10 minutes prior to their lesson starting and returning to school approximately 20 minutes after the lesson has finished.

Please return the attached swimming enrolment form for your child before next Friday, 11th March. Please refer to the back of this page for further information.

We may need to reschedule lessons if directed by the Chief Medical Health Officer or the Department of Education. If this occurs, we will email parents. If a child needs to be collected or taken to the Waroona Recreation Centre separately, the school vehicle may be used with two staff members to maintain child safe practices.
