## **STEMathon Code Conduct**

A code of conduct serves as a set of guidelines and expectations for behaviour, ensuring a safe, respectful, and inclusive environment for all participants involved in the STEMathon event. It outlines the principles of conduct that everyone is expected to adhere to during the event.

### Participants, including school students, children, and attendees, are expected to:

- Treat fellow participants, volunteers, staff, and presenters with kindness, respect, and consideration.
- Take care of equipment, materials, and the venue surroundings, and refrain from causing damage, stealing or disruption.

#### **Event staff members are expected to:**

- Provide assistance: Offer guidance, support, and assistance to participants, volunteers, and attendees as needed.
- Ensure safety: Prioritise the safety and well-being of all participants and attendees and promptly address any safety concerns or emergencies.

#### **Volunteers are expected to:**

- Approach tasks with enthusiasm, positivity, and a willingness to help others.
- Maintain the confidentiality of sensitive information shared during the event and respect participants' privacy.

#### **Teachers and parents are expected to:**

- Provide adequate supervision and guidance to children under their care, ensuring their safety and well-being throughout the event.
- Encourage children to collaborate, share ideas, and engage in cooperative learning experiences with others.
