

Waroona Lions and Leos Clubs with support from the Shire of Waroona, will run **PaddleFest** 2024 concurrently with TroutFest on the

7th September 2024 at the Waroona Weir.

PaddleFest welcomes most human powered watercraft to compete as 3 or 6 person teams, in a 2 hour "Pony Express" relay event. Commence at 11am until the finish flag drops at 1pm.

Compete as a relay team for 2 hours, with the aim to complete as many laps of our triangular, anticlockwise course on the Waroona Weir, as possible.

Check the classifications below. There is a watercraft classification that will suit most paddlers. Trophies will be awarded for first place only.

- 1. Junior sit-on kayaks. (All 3 team members must be aged 15 years or younger)
- 2. Senior sit-on kayaks. (3 team members. No age restriction)
- 3. Pedal kayaks (3 team members. No age restriction)
- 4. Sit-in canoes (3 team members. No age restriction)
- 5. Surf-skis (3 team members. No age restriction)
- 6. Stand-up paddle boards. (3 team members. No age restriction)
- 7. 2 person kayaks (6 team members. No age restriction. 2 people in craft always)
- 8. 2 person canoes (6 team members. No age restriction. 2 people in craft always)
- 9. Youngest 3-person combined team age.
- 10. Oldest 3-person combined team age.
- 11. Most laps by a school team.
- 12. Most laps by a sporting group team.
- 13. Most laps by an employer group team.
- 14. Best presented team costume. (Fancy dress?)
