Sacred Liturgy

Last Friday our dedicated staff developed their knowledge and understanding of Prayer and the Sacred Liturgy with Dr (Sister) Margaret Scharf and Father Con. The day was very informative and engaging with Sister and I thank Jenny Gorman for organising.

Parent and caregiver access from Monday 8th June:

The Minister for Education has advised that parents and caregivers are allowed onto school grounds to drop off and collect their children. The Minister has requested that social distancing is maintained between all parents and teachers. Also, to ensure the 2m2 rule per adult is adhered to, parents are asked not to enter classrooms at the beginning or end of the school day. If you do want to meet with your child's classroom teacher please email or message via Seesaw to arrange an appointment after school hours.

Assemblies and school and Community Events:

The current restrictions enable school events to recommence provided the total does not exceed 100 people for indoor settings and not exceeding 300 people in outdoor settings. As it is Winter, the weather is unpredictable and our overall numbers exceed 100 at this stage we will be running virtual Merit assemblies on Fridays. A link will be sent home so parents can share the joy of their children receiving awards. As the restrictions continue to ease school events will be reviewed.

P & F Meeting

All are invited to the P & F Meeting at 4:30pm on Tuesday 9th July in the school library.

Pre-Kindy playgroup:

We are looking to recommence on Wednesday 18th June and will call parents directly to welcome them back. Pre-Kindy playgroup will be capped at 22 parents (2 sqm per adult) to enable social distancing with other adults and we will request only one parent to attend with their child at this stage. Please note that the square meter and social distancing requirement does not apply to children at school.

Uniforms:

The uniform shop is open on Monday and will be operating on a normal basis whilst maintaining the 2 sqm rule. As it is Winter it is full winter uniform, however, we acknowledge that there are some delays on stock and will not be issuing uniform infringement notes until all stock has arrived.

Canteen:

Thank you for the volunteers that have completed the additional Covid Safe training. The canteen will commence on 15th June and as always welcome anyone who can volunteer.

Reports and Individual Student Plans:

Teachers are currently in the process of teaching and assessing our students. Given the unusual nature of the past term, the reports have been modified for this term and will be issued on Wednesday of Week 10. Student who are on Individual Learning Plans will have these sent home and it would be appreciated if these can be reviewed, signed and returned by parents. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact your child's classroom teacher.

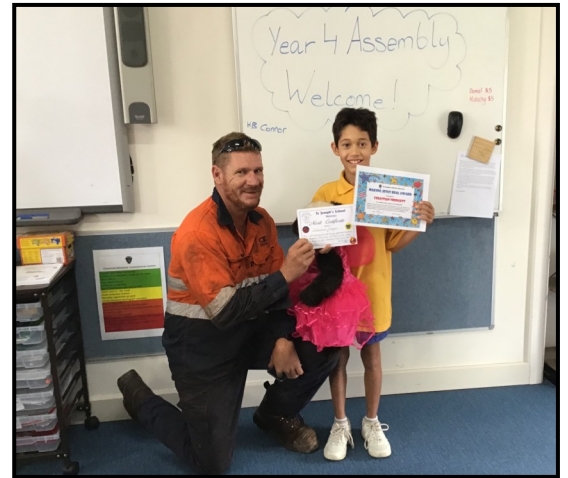
Safety:

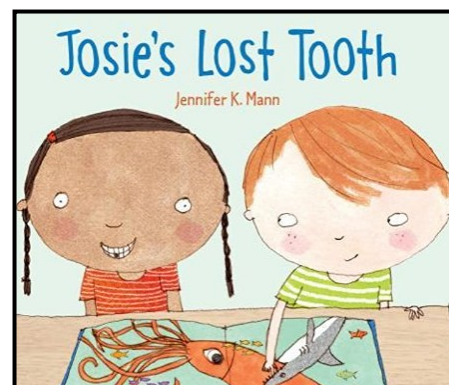
